The CompTIA Cloud+ course will help the student with the knowledge and best practices required of IT practitioners working in cloud computing environments and who must understand and deliver cloud infrastructure.

Prerequisites: CompTIA recommends that candidates have the CompTIA Network+ and/or CompTIA Storage+ certifications; at least 24-36 months of work experience in IT networking, network storage, or data center administration; and familiarity with any major hypervisor technologies for server virtualization.
